Placement	<p>Citations appear in narrative form or fully parenthetical form. In a narrative citation, the author surname or surnames appear as part the sentence. The publication year may either be set apart in parentheses after the surname(s) or be integrated into the sentence.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">This phenomenon occurs frequently in nature, according to Singh and Harris (2018).</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">In 2018, Singh and Harris reported on the frequency with which this phenomenon occurs in nature.</p> <p>In a parenthetical citation, the author surname(s) and the publication year appear together in parentheses. Parenthetical citations should usually be placed at the end of a sentence, before the terminal punctuation (e.g., period).</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">This phenomenon occurs frequently in nature (Singh and Harris 2018).</p> <p>If positioned elsewhere in a sentence, the citation precedes any nonterminal punctuation (e.g., comma, semicolon).</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">This phenomenon occurs frequently in nature (Singh and Harris 2018); however, other phenomena occur more frequently.</p>
Quoted passages and citations	<p>A citation with a page number accompanies a quoted passage. A parenthetical citation is situated after a shorter quoted passage outside the quotation marks. In the citation, a comma is inserted after the publication year, followed by page number or page numbers, without an introductory designator/abbreviation (e.g., “p.” or “pp.”). If the passage falls on a span of pages in the original text, the page numbers are provided in full, connected by an en dash, and if a sentence includes multiple, shorter quoted passages from nonconsecutive pages in the original text, a comma(s) separate(s) the page numbers.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Few would dispute the claim that “science education can promote a valuable—indeed, virtuous—skepticism among young adults” (Liu et al. 2009, 124).</p>

When a narrative citation introduces a shorted quoted passage, the publication year typically appears in parentheses after the author’s name or authors’ names, while the location information appears in a separate parenthetical unit after the quotation.

The publication year and location information appear in the same parenthetical unit, after the author list, if the narrative citation follows the quoted passage.

A quoted passage containing 40 or more words is set in indented “block” form, without enclosing quotation marks. A parenthetical citation appears after the terminal punctuation that closes the block.

If a narrative citation introduces a quoted passage containing 40 or more words, the publication year typically appears in parentheses after the author’s name or authors’ names, while the location information appears in a separate parenthetical unit after the terminal punctuation that closes the block.

[Example]</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Two authors</u></p> <p>Citations of a reference with two credited authors include the surnames of both authors and the publication year. The surnames are separated by “and” in both narrative citations and parenthetical citations. [Example]</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Three or more authors</u></p> <p>Citations of a reference with three or more credited authors include the surname of the first author, followed by “et al.” and the publication year. [Example]</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Organizational authors</u></p> <p>Citations of a reference with a credited organizational author feature an abbreviation of the organization’s name if the reference entry’s author listing includes the abbreviation. [Example]</p> <p>If the reference entry’s author listing omits an abbreviation, citations should display the organization's name in full and should not introduce an abbreviation. [Example]</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>No credited author</u></p> <p>Narrative citations of a journal article, book chapter, magazine article, or newspaper article reference with no credited author display the reference's title with title case formatting (headline capitalization) inside quotation marks. Parenthetical citations display a shortened version of the reference's title in sentence case followed by an ellipsis, without quotation marks. [Example]</p> <p>Narrative citations of a book, report, or website reference with no credited author display the reference's title with title case formatting (headline capitalization) in italics. Parenthetical citations display a shortened version of the reference's title in sentence case followed by an ellipsis, without italics typeface. [Example]</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Same surname but different given-name initials for first authors and same publication years</u></p> <p>Citations of references published during the same year credited to first authors with the same surname but different given-name initials are distinguished by adding the authors’ given-name initials to the citations. In narrative citations the initials appear, with periods, before the identical surnames, and in parenthetical citations, the initials appear, without periods, after the identical surnames. 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Same surname and given-name initials for first authors and same publication years</u></p> <p>If multiple references that include (a) three to five authors, (b) first authors with the same given-name initials and surnames, and (c) the same publication years exist, the references are not cited in the usual contracted form. The author lists in citations are extended to feature the given-name initials and surnames of enough authors, beyond the first author, to show the differences among these references.</p> <p><i>Narrative:</i> G. Parnell, A. C. Foster, et al. (2018) and G. Parnell, R. I. Klein, et al. (2018)</p> <p><i>Parenthetical:</i> (Parnell G, Foster AC, et al. 2018; Parnell G, Klein RI, et al. 2018)</p>
<p>Publication year</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Full dates</u></p> <p>A reference entry for conference presentations, newspaper or magazine article, webpage, television episode, or patent features a full date, with a year followed by an abbreviated month, and often a day (in yyyy Mon dd format). The citation of such a reference, though, omits the month and day and includes only year. [Example]</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Forthcoming</u></p> <p>The word “[forthcoming]” in square brackets replaces the publication year in citations of a reference that has been accepted for publication but has not yet been published in any form (online or print). [Example]</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>No date/Date unknown</u></p> <p>The phrase “[date unknown]” in square brackets replaces the publication year in citations of a reference with no identified publication date. [Example]</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Circa/Approximate dates</u></p> <p>In citations of a reference with an approximate (i.e., “circa”) publication date, square brackets enclose the publication year or year range. A question mark follows the year inside the brackets. [Example]</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Same authors with same publication years</u></p> <p>Alphabetical designators (“a,” “b,” “c”) are affixed to the publication years in entries for references with identical author listings published in the same year. Citations of such references carry the same designators. These alphabetical designators are used to differentiate among reference entries for resources published in the same year with six or more credited authors whose listings have been truncated to feature first authors with the same surnames and given-name initials followed by “et al.”</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Murakami et al. In such a case, semicolons separate the citations.</p> <p><i>Narrative:</i> Ludke (1994, 2000a, 2000b, [date unknown], [forthcoming])</p> <p><i>Parenthetical:</i> (Ludke 1994, 2000a, 2000b, [date unknown], [forthcoming])</p> <p><i>Narrative with locations:</i> Ludke (1994, 897; 2000a; 2000b, 55; [date unknown]; [forthcoming])</p> <p><i>Parenthetical with locations:</i> (Ludke 1994, 897; 2000a; 2000b, 55; [date unknown]; [forthcoming])</p> <p>When multiple references credited to various authors are cited together, the citations are, first, arranged in chronological order (a) dated citations, (b) “[date unknown]” citations, and (c) “[forthcoming]” citations. Tables and figures	<p>Citations are usually included in table footnotes, rather than in the table body. If they do appear in the table body, the citations are placed in a separate column or row with an appropriate heading. Citations are best incorporated into figure captions, rather than into graphics.</p>

References

Principles

The reference section is positioned at the end of the main text under the heading “References.” The section includes entries for all works cited throughout the text. The following rules apply to the arrangement of entries in the section:

1. Reference entries are ordered alphabetically by their first authors’ surnames.
2. Reference entries credited to first authors who share surnames are ordered alphabetically by the first authors’ given-name initials.
3. Reference entries credited to the same first authors, with identical surnames and given-name initials, are ordered in this manner:
 - References with one author appear first.
 - References with truncated author lists—one author followed by “et al.”—appear next.
 - References with two to five authors follow, ordered alphabetically by the subsequent authors’ surnames and given-name initials.
4. Reference entries featuring the same author lists are ordered chronologically by their publication dates (first, dated entries—precise and estimated dates, together; then, “[date unknown]” entries; finally, “[forthcoming]” entries).
5. Reference entries featuring the same author lists and the same publication dates are ordered alphabetically by their titles, with introductory articles (“A,” “An,” “The”) ignored. Lowercase alphabetical designators (“a,” “b,” “c,” etc.) are affixed to the publication years of entries in this subset of references.
6. Reference entries with organizational authors are ordered alphabetically among the other entries by the organizations’ names. Introductory articles (“A,” “An,” “The”) and abbreviations/acronyms, if provided, are ignored.
7. Reference entries with no credited authors are ordered alphabetically among the other entries by their titles. Introductory articles (“A,” “An,” “The”) are ignored.

Instead, the repeated names should be displayed.</p> <p>All reference entries in the section are set with a hanging indent.</p>
<p>Authors and other credited creators</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Author lists</u></p> <p>In a reference entry, the names of individuals credited as authors or principal creators are presented in inverted, surname-first format. Given names are not recorded in full but as initials, without periods after or spaces between the letters. Suffixes (e.g., “Jr”) are positioned after the given-name initials. No commas separate the surname, given-name initial, and suffix elements of an author’s name.</p> <p>The name of an organization credited as an author is recorded in full. If an organizational initialism or acronym is employed for in-text citations, the initialism or acronym appears before the organization’s full name in the reference entry. Square brackets enclose the acronym or abbreviation.</p>

	<p>[Example of organizational author without initialism or acronym], [Example of organizational author with initialism or acronym]</p> <p>No conjunction—neither “and” nor an ampersand (“&”)—appears before the final author’s name unit in any entry with two to five credited authors. Commas separate individual authors’ name units in a reference entry’s author list with two to five credited authors. If a list mixes individual and organizational authors, a semicolon separates the individual author(s) and the organizational author(s). Semicolons also separate organizational author names in lists with multiple organizational authors. If six or more authors are associated with a reference, the entry presents the first credited author, followed by the phrase “et al.”</p> <p>[Example of list with one author], [Example of list with two to five authors], [Example of list with individual and organizational authors], [Example of list with multiple organizational authors], [Example of list with six or more authors]</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Other lists</u></p> <p>Editors may stand before a title element in a reference entry as the resource’s principal creators, if no authors can be credited. When this occurs, the names in such a list are formatted in accordance with the same rules that govern the formatting of names in author lists. The label “editor” ends the list if one editor serves the principal-creator role, and the label “editors” ends the list if multiple editors fill the author positions in the reference entry. The roles of other principal creators, such as film directors and the inventors of patented products, are documented in similar fashions.</p> <p>[Example of editor in author list], [Example of editors in author list], [Example of film director in author list], [Example of patent inventors in author list]</p> <p>If the reference entry credits an author or authors, editor and/or translator names are added as a secondary list after a title element. Names in such secondary lists are presented much as they are in author/principal creator lists: surnames first, followed by given-name initials, with no comma separating the unit’s main elements and no periods or spaces separating given-name initials. Labels placed at the end of the secondary lists identify the non-principal creators’ roles, with plural labels (i.e., “editors” and “translators”) reserved for lists that credit more than one nonprincipal creator.</p> <p>No conjunction—neither “and” nor an ampersand (“&”)—appears before the final name unit in a secondary list with two to five nonprincipal creators. Commas separate name units in a secondary list with two to five nonprincipal creators. If six or more nonprincipal creators are associated with a reference, the entry presents the first credited nonprincipal creator, followed by the phrase “et al.”</p>
	<p>[Example of editor in secondary list], [Example of editors in secondary list], [Example of translator in secondary list], [Example of translators in secondary list]</p>

<p>Periodical resources</p>	<p>The title of an article published in a journal, magazine, or newspaper is set in sentence case using Roman font in a reference entry. The title of a journal is abbreviated based on ISO/LTWA standards. The abbreviated journal title is set using Roman font, without interstitial periods. One-word journal titles are not abbreviated. Newspaper titles are not abbreviated and are set in title case using Roman font.</p> <p>The reference entry for an article that has published in a journal whose volumes are divided into issues features a volume number and an issue number, enclosed in parentheses, even if issues within the volume are continuously paginated. An issue number is omitted from an article’s reference entry if the publishing journal’s volumes are not divided into issues.</p> <p>[Example with issue number], [Example without issue number]</p> <p>The opening page and the closing page in the page range of a journal article’s reference entry are connected through an en dash. All digits in the page range are displayed. Digits in the thousands, hundred, and/or tens places of the opening page number that are repeated in closing page number are not suppressed in the reference entry’s page range.</p>
<p>Nonperiodical resources</p>	<p>The title of a book chapter, book, report, dissertation, or thesis is set in sentence case using Roman font in a reference entry.</p> <p>A reference entry for a book or report includes the name of the publisher under most circumstances but omits the publisher’s location. An entry for a dissertation or thesis, similarly, features the name of the awarding institution but excludes the institution’s location.</p> <p>The reference entry for a book chapter closes with a page range. The abbreviation “p” (without a period) appears before the book chapter’s page range. The opening page and the closing page are connected through an en dash. All digits in the page range are displayed. Digits in the thousands, hundred, and/or tens places of the opening page number that are repeated in closing page number are not suppressed in the reference entry’s page range.</p> <p>[Example of book chapter reference]</p>

<p>Author-supplied translated titles</p>	<p>Under most circumstances, if a reference entry features a non-English title, an author should supply an English-language translation of the title. The translated title, enclosed in square brackets and set in roman font, is inserted after the original title. The capitalization rules of the original language determine the case of the non-English title. Sentence-case formatting, though, is applied to the translated title. In the reference entry for a journal article or a book chapter, an English translation should be provided only for a non-English article or chapter title, not for the journal or book title. A brief note identifying the resource’s original language closes the reference entry, unless the entry ends with a URL or DOI, as is the case with a journal article’s reference entry.</p> <p>[Example of translated title for journal article], [Example of translated title for book], [Example of translated title for book chapter]</p> <p>Journals that publish non-English content may not uphold this style convention. For such journals, providing English-language translations for titles throughout the reference section may not be desirable. When preparing a manuscript for a journal that publishes content written in a language other than English, an author should consult with the journal's editorial office about the preferred convention.</p>
<p>URLs and DOIs</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>URLs</u></p> <p>A uniform resource locator (URL) closes the reference entry for a webpage or other online resource. In the reference entry for a webpage, the author does not record an access date if he or she can determine the resource’s date of publication or latest modification. The author records the date on which he or she accessed the webpage if he or she cannot identify a publication or revision date and must mark the year of publication as “[date unknown].” An access date is also added before the URL in the reference entry for software if no version number can be identified.</p> <p>[Example of webpage without access date], [Example of webpage with access date], [Example of software with access date]</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>DOIs</u></p> <p>Digital object identifiers (DOIs) are commonly featured in reference entries for journal articles, as well as in entries for other types of electronic resources. Authors do not need to include DOIs for published journal articles when preparing manuscripts. If they are retrievable from registries, the DOIs for published journal articles will be added to entries as links in International DOI Foundation format during the production process.</p>
